## **Mass Intentions**

Offering a mass intention is an ancient practice, dating back to the early Church, and much beloved here at Immaculate Conception. For a particular person or general need, we will accept one offering per month and up to six per year. 	<u>Baptisms</u>
\$ 0.00	We are pleased to offer the sacrament of Holy Baptism to all of our <b>registered parishioners</b> at no cost. It is customary to offer a small stipend to the priest or deacon performing the sacrament.
\$100.00	A nominal fee is charged for <b>families that are not members of Immaculate Conception</b> and do not financially support our parish. This fee is considered a donation to the church for the use of its facilities. It is customary to offer a small stipend to the priest or deacon performing the sacrament.
	<u>Funerals</u>
\$550.00	This fee is for registered and financially contributing members of Immaculate Conception and includes a stipend for the clergy, musician, and cantor, with the remainder retained by the parish to pay for the funeral intake and the use of the facilities.
\$650.00	This fee is for non-members of Immaculate Conception and includes a stipend for the clergy, musician, and cantor, with the remainder retained by the parish to pay for our funeral coordinator and the use of the facilities.
	<u>Funeral Luncheons</u>
\$ 75.00	This fee is for registered and financially contributing members of Immaculate Conception and helps us recover our costs related to paper and plastic products, placemats, beverages, set-up and cleanup.
\$100.00	This fee is for non-members of Immaculate Conception and helps us recover our costs related to electricity, water, paper and plastic products, beverages, set-up and cleanup.

## Weddings

\$600.00 This fee is for **registered and financially contributing members of Immaculate Conception** and includes a stipend for our wedding coordinator, clergy, musician, and cantor, with the remainder retained by the parish to pay for the use of the church facility for the rehearsal and wedding. Couples have access to decorate the church 3-hours prior to the start of the ceremony.

\$750.00 This fee is for **non-members of Immaculate Conception** and includes a stipend for our wedding coordinator, clergy, musician, and cantor, with the remainder retained by the parish to pay for the use of the church facility for the rehearsal and wedding. Couples have access to decorate the church 3-hours prior to the start of the ceremony.

Membership is determined by a parish database search which indicates active status. This designation is a combination of consistent participation in the sacramental life of the parish as well as financial support to continue the work of the parish within the community and Archdiocese.
